
## The 2022 Martha A. Davis Greek Declamation Contest

## You will be judged on the following:

- 1. Pronunciation
- 2. Accuracy of Dactylic Hexameter
- 3. Interpretation of the Text
- 4. Smoothness of Delivery
- 5. Appropriate Use of Gestures (Use of costumes and appropriate background is encouraged, but not required.)
- 6. Demeanor
- 7. Textual Accuracy
